Sewer and Water Rates Update

Projected water and sewer rate increases will be discussed at the November 7 meeting.

Sewer for residential and commercial:

- 1/1/2024–12/31/2024: \$33.50/month + \$2.20 per 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.
- 1/1/2025–12/31/2025: \$36.50/month + \$2.35 per 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.
- 1/1/2026 and beyond: \$40.00/month + \$2.50 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.

Water for residential and commercial:

• Beginning 1/1/2024: \$34.00/month + \$1.25 per 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.

Operating and/or Maintenance Agreement with Nebraska Public Power District The board will be discussing the possibility of entering into an operating and/or maintenance agreement with Nebraska Public Power District at the November board meeting.
