



# Lodgepole Update

## From the Board

**Sewer and water rate increases effective January 1, 2024:**

**Sewer** for residential and commercial:

- 1/1/2024 – 12/31/2024: \$33.50/month + \$2.20 per 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.
- 1/1/2025 – 12/31/2025: \$36.50/month + \$2.35 per 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.
- 1/1/2026 and beyond: \$40.00/month + \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.

**Water** for residential and commercial:

- Beginning 1/1/2024: \$34.00/month + \$1.25 per 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof of usage.

At the December Board meeting, the Board voted to enter into a Professional agreement with Nebraska Public Power District. Over the next 6–12 months the management of Lodgepole's electrical infrastructure and billing will transition to NPPD. At the end of the transition period, the Village utility bill will be for water, sewer, and sanitation. Customers will receive a separate electric bill from NPPD.

The next Board meeting is January 2, 2024, at 7 p.m. in the PAC, 630 Orchard Street, Lodgepole, and is open to the public. Finalized agendas will be available online and at the PAC.

## Renewing Your Licenses:

### What You Need to Know

To maintain a valid license, all licenses must be renewed on a yearly basis. Here are the fees for a Dog and UTV/ATV license, and what's required to renew each one:

- **Dog licenses:** \$2 and must include a current rabies certificate.
- **UTV/ATV licenses:** \$25 each and must include proof of insurance and a copy of your driver's license.
