### THIS & THAT FROM VILLAGE OFFICE

The Village of Lodgepole Board of Trustees passed a  
new ordinance for the Off-Road Vehicles. Permits  
have been ordered and them and registrations will be  
issued once they are here. Registration is \$25/year.  
If you own an Off-Road Vehicle (ATV, Kubota, Golf  
Cart, etc.) that you drive on the streets within city  
limits, you will need to register them at the Village  
Office, 630 Orchard Street to be in compliance with  
the ordinance. Please call (483-5353) or stop by the  
Village Office during business hours, 8 am – 12 noon,  
Monday – Fridays to obtain a copy of the new  
ordinance. Thank you!
